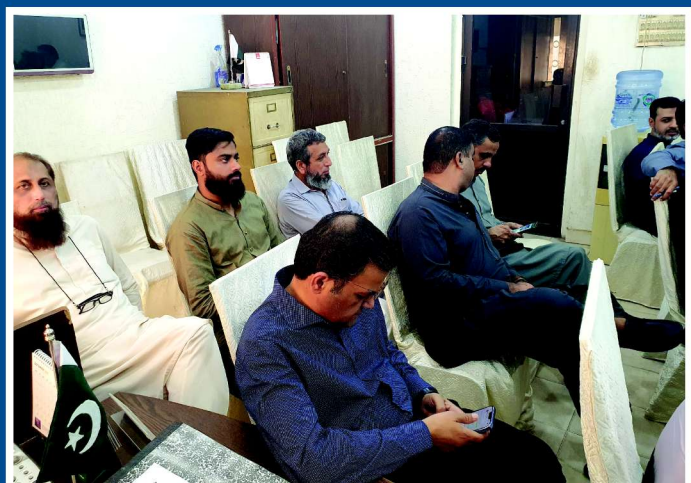

KE representatives also added that the Tajmahal Market cannot be shifted to any other adjoining PMT as the adjoining PMTs are also working at their maximum load levels.

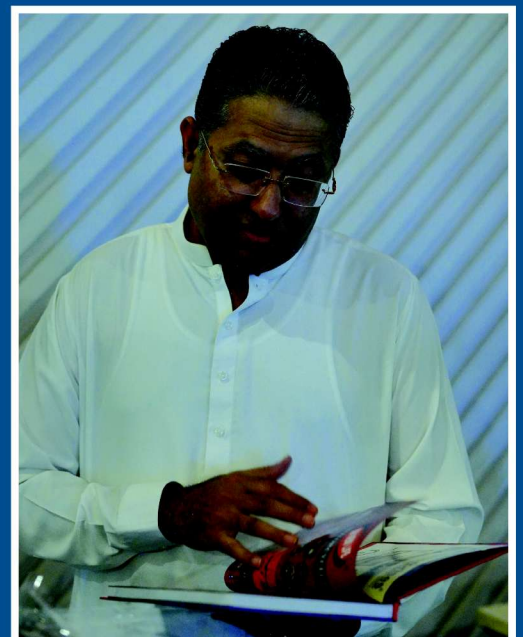

The Office Bearers congratulated the custodians of the newly established Sub-Committees and advised them to initiate their working forthwith by submitting the detailed roadmap for the year. The sub-committees Chairmen were also advised to convene atleast one (1) meeting of their respective committee every month.

iv. Publishing APMSPIDA Diary for the year 2023.

Secretary General apprised the members that the quotation sought from the former printer for the publication of the Diary for the year 2022-23 is exorbitantly high in comparison to last year's quotation and that's due to the ongoing rate of inflation.

The members deliberated on the influence of inflation and advised to seek quotations from other printers as well so that the same be compared with the quotation received from the existing printer. Thereafter the go-ahead be given to the lowest quotation and the working for the Annual Diary of APMSPIDA for the year 2022-23 be initiated. The Chairman of the Diary Committee was advised to initiate work in this respect and accordingly take measures to get the same published way before January 1, 2023, so that it could be disseminated amongst the recipients in time.

v. To discuss the Accounts position of APMSPIDA.

Secretary General apprised the forum that as at 24-11-2022 the accounts position of APMSPIDA stands at Rs. 194452 only.

The members were also apprised that the Annual Diary 2023 Publication will generate Rs. 1 to 1.3 million of funds in the kitty and the membership renewal will also help in generating funds to the kitty. Thus, the same will be totalled around 2 million approximately.

The house expressed their satisfaction over the accounts position of APMSPIDA.

Minutes

The Executive Committee meeting of APMSPIDA commenced with the recitation of the verses from the Holy Quran by Mr. Muhammad Kamran Suleman, member Executive Committee. Thereafter, the Chairman welcomed the members and accordingly asked the Secretary General to table the agenda for the meeting for needful discussion.

1. **Approval of the Minutes of the 1st Executive Committee Meeting (2022-23) held on 26th November 2022**
The minutes of the 1st Executive Committee meeting held on November 26, 2022, of the Executive Committee were tabled for the perusal and needful adoption by the house. Being proposed by Mr. Mr. Faisal Khalil and seconded by Mr. Mr. Yahya Shoukat, the minutes were approved and adopted the minutes as is.

APMSPIDA. Necessary arrangements be made at the respective restaurants where the said sitting could be managed.

4. **To discuss the issues being faced by members with respect to unannounced load shedding.**

The chairman Mr. Nasir Maqbool apprised that with the necessary intervention of Mr. Muhammad Aamir Churra EC Member, the loading shedding has been controlled and now only 1 hour in the morning and 1 hour in the evening the load shedding happens. 
6. **Any other item with the permission of the Chair.**

2. To discuss the Membership Status of APMSPIDA for the year 2023-24.

The house was apprised that the following remained the status of the membership for the year 2023-24:- Renewed 335, Not interested 2, Companies closed 10. The Secretary-General was praised for his activeness in achieving the aforesaid goals by the whole house.

3. To discuss the issues being faced by members with respect to unannounced load shedding.

Mr. Muhammad Aamir Churra Chairman Public Sector, Utility Power & Gas Committee dealing with the said matter apprised the house that at the outset, its not unannounced load shedding as the schedule is already out by the K-Electric. He further added that the load shedding is being carried out throughout the markets due to hot weather. The same remains controlled due to the pressure of APMSPIDA and KCCI. He further said that as there is not many line losses in the vicinity, therefore, things remain controlled. I also spoke to NEPRA Chairman that the areas where there are line losses, the load shedding will take place. However, if we wish to change our PMT or feeder, then expenses will be incurred. He added that the feeders of our area are facing fewer line losses for which they aren't suffering from load shedding as such.

The members highlighted that Tajmahal market is facing massive issues in comparison to Aurangzeb market and the feeders of Tajmahal should be converted to Aurangzeb market as that's the crux to the matter. The house advised the Focal Person to work on converting the feeders of Tajmahal market to Aurangzeb market so that the said issue be curtailed.

Mr. Aamir Churra further apprised that I will take the matter up with KE representatives and will try my best to get the matter sorted out as discussed. Hopefully, the KE representatives will take to access the load and thereafter take measures as desired.

The house expressed their full confidence and appreciation towards the work done by Mr. Aamir Churra and his team.

4. To discuss the Accounts position of APMSPIDA.

The Chairman Mr. M. Arif Siddiqui of the accounts committee apprised that currently, the association has Rs. 828,193 in APMSPIDA Bank account and Cheques in hand Rs. 80000 upcoming Amounts Rs. 150000 total Rs. 1 million plus. He added that the association does have enough money available to meet the expenses likely to be incurred on account of salaries, utility expenses, and other routine expenses. He further added that this time around (by September) it is highly likely that the challans from KMC on account of Rent for the year 2 years will be received from the needful clearance. The same was last received in 2020. So the expenses on the known and the latter account will be easily met by September 2023. After meeting the said expenses, the association will still be left with Rs. 75435 approx in its account. For generating more expenses, from October 2023, the diary publication will start which is a great source of revenue generation for the association.

The Chairman Mr. M. Arif Siddiqui advised that it's high time that the house may think to Enhance the Membership of the Association, Initiating an activity through which added source of income be generated, and also think of enhancing the membership fees of the association from Rs. 2500 as the same remain unchanged from almost 10 years.

5. To check the matters regarding APMSPIDA Diary 2023 Dinner.

The chairman Mr. Shahzad Sarfraz of the Diary Publication Committee apprised the house that in the year 2023, we had printed 2380 diaries in total which is nearly 380 surplus in comparison to the previous year wherein 2000 diaries were printed. He further added that a revenue generation of Rs. 1,286,000 was made which was in surplus of Rs. 137,000 compared to last year. In the year 2023 in total 57 advertisements were published in the diary which was in plus as compared to last year. He added that with the change of printer, all the desired Goals were achieved.

8. Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

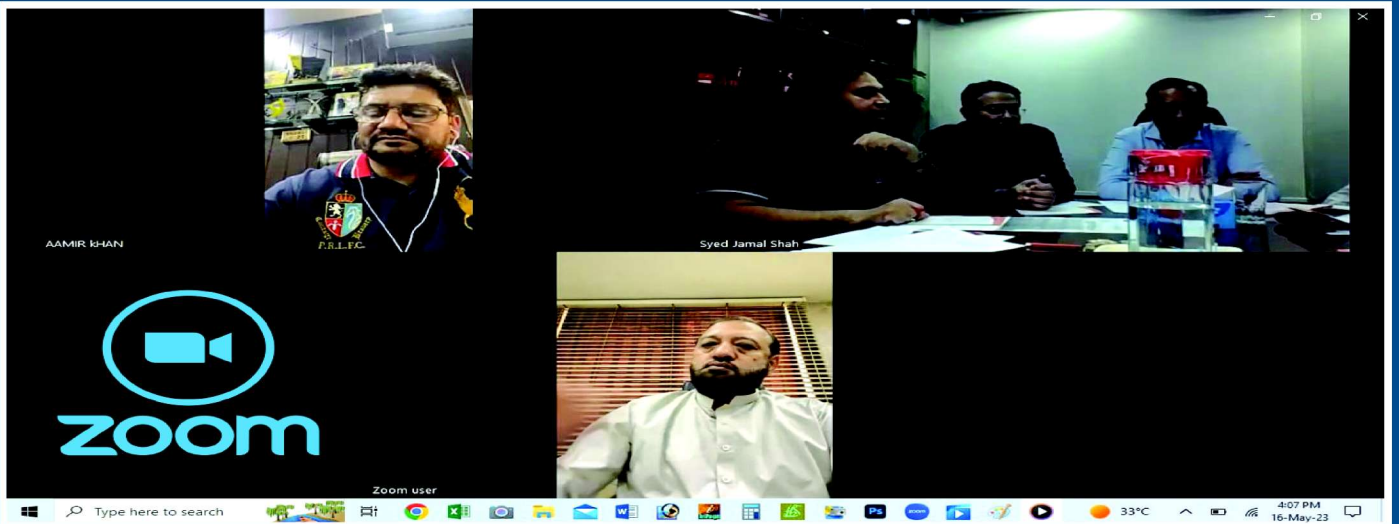

- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with the Management Committee regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

Based on our audit, we further report that in our opinion:

- proper books of account have been kept by the Association as required by the Companies Act, 2017 (XIX of 2017);
- the statement of financial position, the statement of income and expenditure, the statement of changes in fund and the statement of cash flows together with the notes thereon have been drawn up in conformity with the Companies Act, 2017 (XIX of 2017) and are in agreement with the books of account and returns;
- investments made, expenditure incurred and guarantees extended during the year were for the purpose of the Association's business; and
- no Zakat was deductible at source under the Zakat and Ushr Ordinance, 1980 (XVIII of 1980).

1 Status and nature of business.

Fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is provided on reducing balance method. A full year's depreciation is charged on assets purchased during the year but no depreciation is charged on assets disposed off during the year.
