“On 21st October 2024, a meeting was held with the top management of K-Electric, attended by Mr. Faisal Khan (Regional Head K-Electric), Mr. Absar Ahmed (Cluster Head K-Electric), Mr. Faisal Khalil (Vice President KCCI), Mr. Tanvir Barry (Former Chairman Utility Committee KCCI), along with APMSPIDA representatives Mr. Nasir Maqbool (Chairman Utility Committee), Mr. Waqar Ahmed Shaikh (Senior Vice Chairman), and Secretary General Syed Jamal Shah. APMSPIDA highlighted that despite clearing all bills and submitting payment records to IBC Garden, the Motorcycle Spare Parts Market receives only 3 hours of electricity daily, causing severe business disruption and law & order concerns. In response, Regional Head Mr. Faisal Khan assured that a survey will be conducted in the market to identify solutions to this issue.

On 24th October 2024, a high-level K-Electric team along with technical heads and engineers conducted a major survey of Aurangzeb Market, Taj Mahal Market, and Shirazi Market to assess the electricity status and explore possible solutions for APMSPIDA. The survey team termed it one of the largest surveys conducted in the area and assured that a proposed scheme will be shared to help resolve the load shedding issue. While acknowledging that the old city area presents certain line loss challenges, they emphasized that the problem is difficult but not impossible to solve.”

“On 4th November 2024, the K-Electric Technical Team from IBC Garden once again conducted a survey of Aurangzeb and Taj Mahal Market on the request of the Association, assuring that a feasibility survey report will be prepared and every effort will be made to reduce load shedding in Motorcycle Spare Parts Markets.

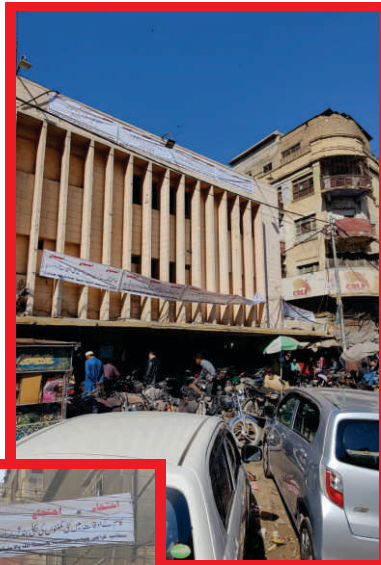

The scheme, involving significant costs, was presented by K-Electric as the only solution to end load shedding in Aurangzeb and Taj Mahal Motorcycle Parts Market if shop owners collectively deposit the amount. Mr. Nasir Maqbool, along with his team, is reviewing the feasibility of this scheme to assess whether it is practical and affordable for the market's small shop owners.”

“On 26th May 2025, Mr. Ejaz Usman (Vice Chairman APMSPIDA) and Mr. Suleman Ilyas (Chairman Social Media Committee) gave an interview to Express News, requesting the government's support in resolving the challenges faced by the Motorcycle Parts Market.



On 11th June 2025, a meeting was held at KCCI with NEPR officials Mr. Safer Hussain and Hafiz Usman from Islamabad to discuss the ongoing load shedding issues. Representing APMSPIDA, Mr. Nasir Maqbool (Chairman Utility Committee) highlighted the prolonged power outages in the Motorcycle Spare Parts Market and informed that despite continuous efforts with K-Electric, no relief has been provided. He requested NEPR's support in taking up the matter with K-Electric. The NEPR team assured that they will raise the issue with higher authorities in Islamabad to seek a solution.”

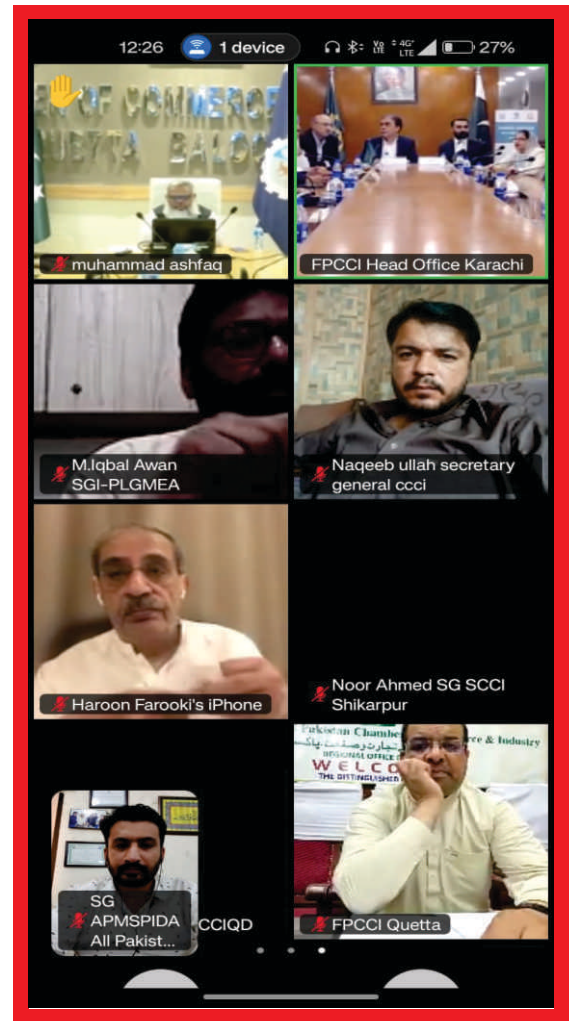
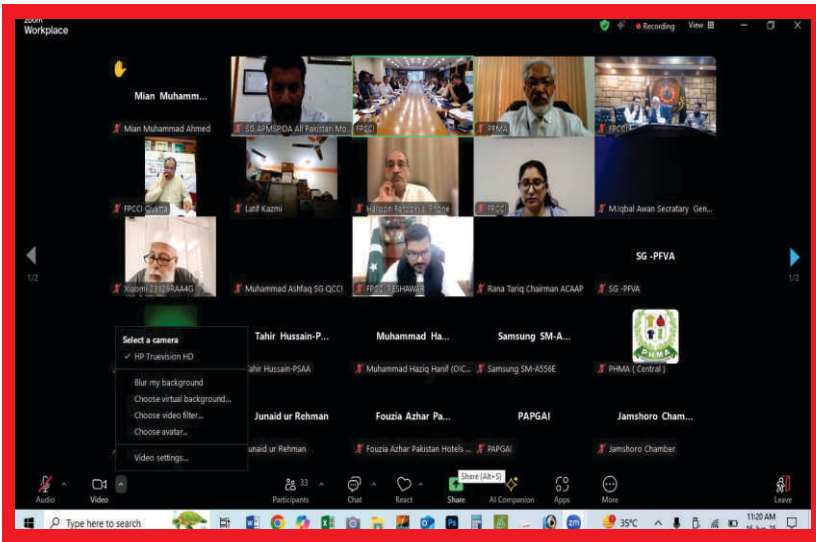



- 3. To discuss and initiate the printing process of APMSPIDA Diary for the year 2025.**

**Minutes**

The Executive Committee meeting of APMSPIDA commenced with the recitation of the verses from the Holy Quran by Mr. Ejaz Usman, Vice Chairman. Thereafter, the Chairman welcomed the members and accordingly asked the Secretary to table the agenda for the meeting for needful discussion.

1. **Approval of the Minutes of 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee 2024-26 held on 5th October, 2024.**  
The minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee held on 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2024 after being proposed by Mr. Mr. Abdul Qader and seconded by Mr. Faisal Qayyum were adopted by the house.
2. **To discuss the issues being faced by members with respect to unannounced load shedding.**  
The Chairman of APMSPIDA applauded the efforts of the Chairpersons and members of the Sub-Committees of APMSPIDA and backed them with his wishes and prayers.  
The Ex-officio while taking the floor apprised the members that the loadshedding issue was discussed in detail with the KE team, who had quoted Rs. 88 lacs in order to carry out desirable changes in order to address the ongoing issues. He further added that no negotiations could be managed from the KE except for a meager amount of Rs. 4-5 lacs only. He further added that in order to gather figure from the market shop keepers 4 categories could be managed whereby 1<sup>st</sup> category shop keepers were allotted Rs. 100k each, 2<sup>nd</sup> category be allotted Rs. 50k, 3<sup>rd</sup> category was allotted Rs. 30k and 4<sup>th</sup> category be allotted Rs. 15k each. In total Rs. 74 lacs are likely to be collected but still 98 lacs in a far ahead figure. He added that KE people aren't budging down any further and in addition to all the collection of funds, we'll have to ensure the security of the said PMT which would be a cumbersome task.  
Members advised that we should carryout decent protest against KE so that they could reduce the said amounts and address the issues in hand. Chairman advised that we better wait till December 2024 as KCC&I has advised us to wait until then to address the issue. Chairman also advised that installation of solar panels in the market be discussed and chalked out with KE people and minutes of the same be shared in the next meeting.
3. **To discuss the current status of the publication of the APMSPIDA Diary for the year 2025.**  
The Chairman of the Publication Committee apprised the house that until now, we've met the last years profit margins and we are further hoping that additional funds will be generated as a few

members are travelling abroad. Hopefully, in next few days, additional funds will be managed accordingly. The Chairman of the Publication Committee apprised that the designing of the diary has been maneuvered and until now 70% working has been achieved. He added that the printer has been released 900k as an advance payment and the leftover amounts will be released after the release of 100% printable material by him to us. The Chairman further apprised that if 100% advertisements are received by November 30, then we will be able to deliver the printed diaries by the 1<sup>st</sup> week of January 2025. He added that 60% printable material has been delivered to the printer which is a positive sign. He added that a notebook is being prepared instead of a diary as it won't have a calendar to it, meaning thereby that the same can be used for years.

4. **Discuss placement and patrolling timings of the Police vehicle(s).**  
Chairman Law & Order apprised the house that proper police patrolling is being managed in the market. The patrolling party is available by 8pm and requests that maximum shopkeepers close their shops by 8pm. However, there are instances where a few shopkeepers keep their shops open after 8pm which creates an issue for the patrolling team. The house advised that a notice be issued to all such shopkeepers advising them to cooperate in this respect. Further they also decided that tubular lights be installed in the market in order to ensure lighting in the market in the night hours.
5. **To discuss the Accounts position of APMSPIDA.**  
The Chairman of the Accounts committee apprised that Rs. 115k are available in the account and 900k have been released to the printer. The funds position remains okay and consistent. He further added that 1 month salary for the month of December 2024 can easily be managed through the accumulated funds. He added that diary publication profit is likely to enhance more in comparison to last year.
6. **Any other item with the permission of the Chair.**  
The following items were discussed further:-
  - i. Encroachment issues are enhancing due to careless attitude of the shopkeepers which is likely to become chronic. Members advised that Land encroachment be approached in order to address the issue in hand. Shirazee Market is the most affected.
  - ii. Chairman apprised that sub committees have been formulated at the level of KCC&I on the request of APMSPIDA in which members should take maximum interest. The members assured their maximum support and cooperation in this respect.
